SWEET CANDY COMPANY FACTORY TOUR GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL GROUPS

We are excited to welcome your school group to the Sweet Candy Company Factory Tour! Our goal is to show students a working factory and share how we use the subjects they are studying in school (computers, mathematics and science) in our candy plant. Following are some guidelines that will make your visit even “Sweeter”. Please review these rules with your children and chaperones prior to your visit:

- **Special Notice:** We use many different nuts in our building, specifically almonds and peanuts. Please be aware of anyone in your touring party that has any nut allergies! Persons with severe allergies to even nut dust should not enter our building. Also, we use eggs, soy, and milk in some of our products. If you have allergies to any of these or other ingredients, please tell us beforehand so that we can provide you with information on which products contain those ingredients.
- We require that you have one adult chaperone for every seven (7) children.
- Everyone must wear a hair net (and beard net if applicable) to tour the factory. We will provide these free for you when you arrive.
- Everyone will be asked to remove all jewelry such as watches, rings, earrings, bracelets. This includes wedding rings and bands. Medical ID tags are okay.
- No cell phones, purses, backpacks, cameras, coats, or other personal items are allowed in the factory. Please leave these at school or in your vehicles.
- No food, drinks, or chewing gum are allowed in the factory.
- There will be yellow lines on the factory floor marking the tour path. Please stay within these lines and do not touch anything unless your tour guide instructs you to do so. You will be right on the floor of a working factory. It will be noisy and the smells are sweet and strong.
- There are rest rooms provided for your use in the welcome area, but not in the factory. Please use them, if needed, before the tour begins.
- Please wear comfortable walking shoes. Open-toed shoes, “wheeled shoes” and flip-flops are unsafe when worn in the plant.
- Please wear long pants for safety purposes.
- Please note that we do have a factory outlet candy store, but we will bypass this with your school group. You are all welcome to come back another time with your families and friends to purchase candy. When appropriate, we will provide each guest with samples of our candy.
- Please let your tour guide know at the beginning of your tour if you would like any particular curriculum-related information. We can highlight careers, mathematics or computers in the workplace, or nutrition information.
- We have free parking around our building. Buses may park in our truck loading area accessed from 3800 West. Have the drivers park along the southern curb of this parking
